3. Open Forum

- *Roadshows*
Tony continues to add new events for 2019. We attended 33 events last year.
NHW will continue to help provide property marking and crime prevention advice. Please try to attend an event if there is one advertised in your area and pick up some property marking pens to enable you to do your own property marking. Property marking helps the Police to get stolen items back to the owner and also helps the Police link an offender to a crime and get a conviction.
- *Core Security Products* Good stocks of Minder Signal Blockers – Small /Large (£3 each). They are a protective storage pouch. Pouch protects against remote entry / keyless entry signals being stolen from Key Fobs. 'Relay' theft is on the rise. This can occur even when the car key is inside your house. The pouches continue to be well received at Roadshows.
- We have been continuing our support of free items enabling residents to property mark their property and protect themselves from purse snatching. These free items have been funded by the PCC...
- *NHW Support* NWNHW will continue to offer our assistance to the SNT's across North Warwickshire when attending events in local communities. It is hoped that our attendance will greatly improve the link between NHW co-ordinators and also improve ongoing support across the NW area.
- *NWNHW Meetings:* We will continue to hold our current 6 meetings across 3 venues for 2019. Review of frequency and venues ongoing.
- *Venues* – Tony would like to pass on our thanks to the venue organisers where we hold our meetings. A special thanks to the Grimstock Hotel for their support.
- No other items raised additional to those reported below
- *Security Product Price List:* The Security Product price list has been updated for 2019 and is on our website. Members will be able to download a copy from our website. New products have been added in the update.
- NWNHW – Following the success of house to house visits on new housing estates, we are planning more visits to new properties and will be handing out more of our home security advice packs and property marking pens. We have received positive feedback from residents visited so far. We also hope to hold a series of property marking events. Thank you to North Warwickshire Police for providing NHW with a selection of crime prevention leaflets.
- NHW to investigate sharing information through local Community Magazines, Parish Councils, Libraries and Doctors Surgeries.
- Residents were asked to continue to report incidents or suspicious activity to the Police as soon as possible as this would help the Police deal with local issues.
- Avoid being a victim of car crime by making sure that you do not leave any valuables or even small change on view. Remove your tools from vans overnight. If you have a shed or garage, consider fitting a shed alarm. These alarms are not expensive but can be very effective.
- Tony advised that Neighbourhood Watch schemes have access to holiday security packs that can be loaned from NHW whilst residents are on holiday. Each pack consists of a number of items to help improve your security whilst you are away on holiday.
- Members reminded to remain vigilant especially around holiday periods. Residents should review their security and consider using simple devices such as timer switches to turn lights on at night and play music. Do not leave rubbish bins out while you are on holiday. Further home security advice is available on the Warwickshire Police and Warwickshire Rural Watch websites.

Datalink These continue to be popular at the Road Shows and have been widely distributed. Sufficient stock for Roadshows.

Smart Water

NWNHW continues to offer supplies of Smart Water via a voucher scheme. The kits will property mark up to 30 items and are available through NWNHW at a cost of £11 each.

Guidance notes on erection criteria for street signs and application forms for completion and submission to the Highway authority are available on request from Core Group members.

Rural Crime Project

Car Anti Tamper screws - Note: This is an ongoing issue to guard against in that an element of car crime is directed at stealing number plates for criminal purposes. This is an easy crime to counter by using the screws that we provide FREE. An increasing number of people are using the screws for caravan plates too.

Use the application form (available on line), copy and pass them around your Watch area.

There are still cases of theft arising around the Borough but not focussed on any particular area at this time.

Tony Hardman is running the scheme throughout North Warwickshire on behalf of the force and the NW Association. FREE anti tamper number plate screws are also available at the Coleshill Hub, Coleshill library, Polesworth and Atherstone libraries and through individual coordinators in their watch areas.

6. **Police Update NWN SNT/ NWE SNT** – Update received from Scot Ramsell

PC Scot Ramsell thanked Tony and the NHW team for their support. He also thanked NHW co-ordinators for their support and help. Useful intelligence is being received from residents and investigated.

There has been an increase in vehicle crime across all 4 areas of North Warwickshire (theft of motor vehicles and theft from motor vehicles. Coleshill has been hit hard and the team will be target hardening properties with high value vehicles. A Mitsubishi L200 was recovered locally today.

Recent issues with offenders trying to open car doors and 9/10 incidents have involved theft where owners have left valuables such as laptops, mobile phones and handbags in their vehicles which encourages more opportunities for offences.

There have been a couple of number plate thefts. Free anti-tamper screws are available from local libraries and NHW. Burglary and ASB figures are down. There has been an increase in patrols targeting ASB. A number of Special Constables have been working out of Coleshill covering all 4 areas of North Warwickshire.

North Warwickshire East SNT are arranging a Multi-Agency event in Atherstone, and a Van crime prevention initiative with free van crime prevention packs available to all van owners.

There have been reports of unauthorised scrap people operating in the Atherstone area. Residents are urged not to put out old equipment as offenders sometimes pick up items from your property and use the time to check out your property prior to a burglary.

North Warwickshire North SNT are arranging community engagement days and mini ASB operations to target ASB hot spots.

Warwickshire Rural Watch and the local SNT will be at the Whitacre & Fillongley show.

A new Warwickshire Rural Crime County wide team is being set up with a Sergeant and 4 officers.

Two churches have recently been targeted by offenders and the Police are asking the clergy and local residents to be extra vigilant and report any suspicious activity or incidents.

Lea Marston and Wishaw have had a number of ASB incidents and the Police are working to resolve these incidents.

Increase in ASB incidents around Hams Hall with lorry drivers and overnight stayers. Police are working with local partners and have Operation Volt running to target these incidents.

The South and West Safer Neighbourhood Teams will be delivering “Be Internet Legends Internet Safety lessons in 13 primary schools across their area.

The lessons will include Online Safety, People who help us, Stranger Danger and Road Safety. The North & East will look at this for the new school term in September.

Tony thanked Scot for his feedback and support.

PCC wrote to us in December 2018 to offer in-principal funding for North Warwickshire Neighbourhood Watch for the financial year of 2019-20.
